Demountable equipment that enhances the flexibility, safety, ADA compliance and social distancing capacity of live event venues.

Focus:

This course presented by Staging Concepts examines the use of demountable equipment (including platforms, stairs, ramps, railing and seating) with a focus on application, patron safety, building code requirements, social distancing, and structural design in public spaces. The course will educate architects about structural and design considerations, code and ADA compliance, and applications to improve the flexibility of the venue and enhance patron experience. Applicable sections of the International Building Code (IBC) are discussed, as are materials, finishes, options, and how they affect the project budget.
